

HIGH SCHOOL CITIZENSHIP AWARD

RATIONALE:

The High School Citizenship Award recognizes an individual with outstanding characteristics in the areas of academic ability, leadership in school sponsored, community, or extracurricular activities, and a demonstrated willingness to place the good of others above personal ambitions. County Central High School is allocated one award.

RECIPIENTS WILL RECEIVE A PLAQUE AND A LETTER OF COMMENDATION

CRITERIA:

Nominees must:

1. Be Alberta residents
2. Be in their graduating year.
3. Have displayed outstanding characteristics in the following areas:
 - Academic ability
 - Leadership in school sponsored, community or extracurricular activities
 - Willingness to place the good of others above personal ambitions
4. Indicate which post-secondary institution they expect to attend.
5. Be recommended by the Selection Committee at CCHS.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Candidates should apply in writing, indicating how they meet the criteria listed above no later than **June 1** each year. Address your application:
