Andrew Hawthorn Scholarship Trust Fund

Award:

Net annual income derived from the investment of the trust fund to one eligible recipient. \$10,090.89 invested in Canada Marketable Bonds. Currently the scholarship is approximately \$400 per year.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduate from a high school entitling the applicant to receive a high school diploma.
2. Applicant must be a resident of the Carmangay District (that portion of the County of Vulcan No. 2 which lies to the south of the Little Bow River) while attending Grade 12 or its equivalent.
3. Applicant must be a student who would normally attend high school in the Village of Carmangay if such school existed.
4. Applicant must attend a high school within the County of Vulcan No. 2 or any approved high school outside of County.
5. Applicant must graduate with the highest average marks of the other eligible applicants.
6. Applicant must be attending or intending to attend an academic or vocational training facility after graduation.
7. Applicant must apply in writing to the Principal of CCHS no later than **May 1st** of each year.

Special Conditions:

1. If in any year, the scholarship is not awarded, it must be reinvested as part of the principle of the trust fund.
2. The Carmangay District for the purposes of this scholarship is:
"That portion of the County of Vulcan No. 2 which lies to the south of the Little Bow River."

ARROWWOOD LIONS AWARD

Criteria:

- Attend Arrowwood School for at least two years
- Highest marks in core subjects
- Minimum average 70%
- Must be continuing to post-secondary education

This scholarship does not require an application.

The selection committee at County Central High School will determine the eligible grade 12 student with the highest academic average.

Amount of award is \$500.

DANIEL JANTZIE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

CRITERIA:

1. Applicants must be graduating from Grade 12 in the year in which the award is made.
2. Applicants must provide proof of continuing education at a post secondary institution.
3. Student who attains the highest scholastic standing on five Grade 12 subjects in the Advanced Diploma Program at County Central High School.

DR. W. A. PROUDFOOT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

RATIONALE:

The scholarship will be awarded to a student from CCHS selected by the Vulcan Health Care Auxiliary in conjunction with the Hospital Staff, with the recommendation of the scholarship committee of CCHS. The scholarship is valued at \$500.

CRITERIA:

1. The applicant must be a Grade 12 graduate who has been awarded a High School Diploma from County Central High School in the year in which the award is applied for.
2. The applicant must be accepted into a health-related program at a post-secondary education institution.
3. The applicant will be judged on participation in other areas such as school activities and community activities.
4. The applicant must submit an essay (minimum of 1000 words) on "Health Care as a Career".

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Apply in writing to the Principal of CCHS no later than **May 1** of each year. State the scholarship you are applying for and your qualifications. **Include proof of attendance at a post secondary educational facility, a copy of your Grade 12 marks, and your essay.** If you are unable to provide this information with your application, please send it as soon as possible.

DR. M. E. KOZIOL MEMORIAL FUND
MEDICINE AND NURSING

RATIONALE:

The Dr. M.E. Koziol Memorial fund was established in 2002, the year of his passing. It recognizes High School students graduating from the County of Vulcan pursuing a career in medicine, nursing or health sciences. The scholarship is valued at approximately \$450.00.

CRITERIA:

1. **MEDICINE:** This scholarship shall be awarded to graduates who have been accepted into a Canadian Faculty of Medicine (confirmation of enrollment required).

2. **THIRD YEAR NURSING:** In the event there are no applicants meeting the above criteria, this scholarship shall be awarded to graduates entering their third year of an undergraduate degree program in nursing at a recognized Canadian institution (confirmation of enrollment required).

3. **FIRST YEAR – PRE-MED OR NURSING:** In the event there are no applicants meeting the above criteria, this scholarship shall be awarded to graduates accepted into either:
 - a) An undergraduate degree program intended as pre-med. This would be indicated by course selections heavily weighted towards biology, chemistry, physics, biochemistry, physiology, English, mathematics, and psychology (confirmation of enrollment required).

 - or

 - b) A nursing program (degree or diploma) at a recognized Canadian institution (confirmation of enrollment required).

4. **HEALTH SCIENCES:** In the event there are no applicants meeting the above criteria, this scholarship shall be awarded to graduates accepted into health care related studies at a recognized Canadian institution (confirmation of enrollment required).

5. **ATTITUDE:** In the event more than one applicant qualifies, the selection committee has the authority and is directed to choose the individual who they feel exhibits an outstanding attitude of caring, compassion, dignity and humanitarianism to others. The selection committee also has the authority to decide to share the scholarship equally. Either choice is at their discretion. The selection committee and process of deciding the recipient's "attitude" shall be determined by the Vulcan Healthcare Auxiliary.

6. **LONG TERM CARE:** Should no applicant be awarded this scholarship, the selection committee is directed as follows:
 - a) If the monetary value of this fund is less than \$10,000, obtain approval from the Executive Director of the Calgary Foundation and keep the grant money in the fund.

 - b) If the monetary value of this fund is \$10,000 or greater, direct the grant money into the Vulcan Community Health Center to assist with the funding of Long Term Care projects.

HERBERT H. MUMBY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA:

1. Applicants must have obtained the highest average in six Grade 12 subjects at CCHS taken in one year. Each subject must carry a credit weight of 5 credits.
2. If more than six Grade 12 subjects are taken, the average of the highest six marks will be considered.
3. All marks to be considered are the final marks in June of each year.
4. Applicants must be continuing their education at some school of higher learning.
5. One scholarship will be awarded to a girl that meets the criteria. One scholarship will be awarded to a boy that meets the criteria.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Apply in writing to the Principal of CCHS no later than **May 1st** of each year. Award:

Net annual income derived from the investment of the trust fund. Currently the scholarship is approximately \$150 per year.

3. Applicant must have an acceptable academic standing permitting university entrance as determined by teacher-awarded marks.
4. Applicant has financial need as determined by a counsellor and/or school administration.

THE ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION SCHOLARSHIP CHAMPION # 262 LEGION and LADIES AUXILIARY

CRITERIA

1. Applicants must be a child, grandchild, or great grandchild of a member in good standing, of the Ladies Auxiliary or of the Legion, Champion # 262, Royal Canadian Legion.
2. Applicants must be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant and demonstrate high ideals and qualities of good citizenship.
3. Applicants must have been involved or still involved within the Champion Community and have contributed to the community at some level.
4. Applicants must be a graduate from a high school entitling the applicant to receive a high school diploma.
5. Applicants must plan to register as a full-time student in September at a recognized university, community college, technical institute, or other post secondary institution for advanced learning.
6. The winner will be required to submit proof of enrollment prior to receiving the scholarship.

Students applying for this scholarship may apply in the year they graduate, or they may wait for one year, if they so wish, before applying and furthering their education.

Value of the scholarship is \$400.00.
